Women in Politics

- Globally women make up **18.8% of parliamentarians**
- Highest are **Nordic** countries (**42.1%**)
- **Rwanda** is the only country to pass 50% (**56.3%**)
- Lowest are **Arab states** (**9.5%**) and **Pacific Island** states (**15.3%**)
- **16%** of **Ministerial** posts are held by women
- Women **Heads of State**: **6.0%**
- Women **Heads of Government**: **5.7%**
- Women **Heads of Parliament**: **13%**

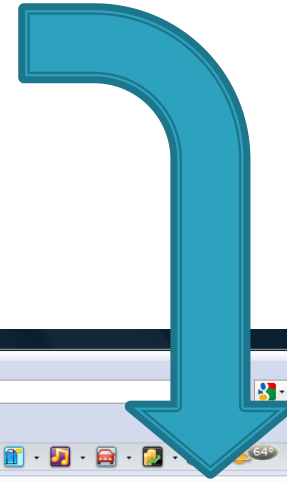
