Women in Politics

- Globally women make up 18.8% of parliamentarians
- Highest are Nordic countries (42.1%)
- Rwanda is the only country to pass 50% (56.3%)
- Lowest are Arab states (9.5%) and Pacific Island states (15.3%)
- 16% of Ministerial posts are held by women
- Women Heads of State: 6.0%
- Women Heads of Government: 5.7%
- Women Heads of Parliament: 13%
